John Cardona knows that you care how information about you is used and shared, and I appreciate your trust that I will do so carefully and sensibly. This notice describes my privacy policy. **By visiting timeofthetestament.com you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Notice.**

What Personal Information About Customers Does timeofthetestament.com Gather?

The information I learn from customers helps me personalize and continually improve your experience on the site. Here are the types of information I gather.

- **Information You Give Me:** I receive and store any information you enter on my Web site or give me in any other way. I use the information that you provide for such purposes as responding to your requests, customizing future shopping for you, improving my products, and communicating with you.
- **Automatic Information:** I receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with me. For example, like many Web sites, I use "cookies," and I obtain certain types of information when your Web browser accesses timeofthetestament.com or advertisements and other content served by or on behalf of timeofthetestament.wixsite.com/johncardona on other Web sites.
- **Mobile:** When you download or use apps created for Time of the Testament or its subsidiaries, I may receive information about your location and your mobile device, including a unique identifier for your device. I may use this information to provide you with location-based services, such as advertising, search results, and other personalized content. Most mobile devices allow you to turn off location services. For more information about this refer to the documentation of your specific device.
- **E-mail Communications:** To help me make e-mails more useful and interesting, I often receive a confirmation when you open e-mail from timeofthetestament.com if your computer supports such capabilities. I also compare my customer list to lists received from other companies, in an effort to avoid sending unnecessary messages to my customers. - **Information from Other Sources:** I might receive information about you from other sources and add it to my account information.

What About Cookies?

- Cookies are unique identifiers that I transfer to your device to enable my systems to recognize your device and to provide features such as a fast viewing experiences, personalized advertisements on other Web sites between visits.
- The Help feature on most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable cookies altogether. Additionally, you can disable or delete similar data used by browser add-ons, such as Flash cookies, by changing the add-on's settings or visiting the Web site of its manufacturer. Because cookies allow you to take advantage of some of timeofthetestament.com essential features, we recommend that you leave them turned on.

Does timeofthetestament.com Share the Information It Receives?

Information about my customers is an important part of my business, and I am not in the business of selling it to others. I share customer information only as described below and with subsidiaries in relation with John Cardona that either are subject to this Privacy Notice or follow practices at least as protective as those described in this Privacy Notice.

- **Third-Party Service Providers:** I employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on my behalf.
